

# United States Power Squadron Early History





### **United States Power Squadron Early History**

- October 1912: Boston Yacht Club Rear Commodore Roger Upton petitioned the Executive Committee to officially establish a, "Power Boat Division"
- January 1913: Name changed to "Power Squadron"
  - United States laws governing navigation applied only to steam vessels, governed by a board of steamboat inspectors who were old, crusty, sea-going men
  - Franklin Delano Roosevelt, then assistant secretary of the Navy and an honorary member of the Boston Yacht Club, had observed Power Squadron drills



# United States Power Squadron Then & Now


- World Wars I & II: FDR (as Assistant Secretary and again as President)
  - Volunteered the entire USPS instructional program for the training of men for naval coastal defense (477 members, 20 Squadrons)
  - Schools were organized by local squadrons in New York City, Boston, Detroit, Newburgh, New Haven and Washington, D.C.
  - Over 8,000 men who attended these classes entered the armed services and, based in significant part on the quality of their USPS training, many were appointed officers

# United States Power Squadron Then & Now

- September 1989: President George Bush signed a proclamation honoring USPS
- Today: Started as a club-within-a-club in the early 1900s, USPS today is a private, self-supporting, non-profit, fraternal boating organization with an incomparable record of achievement
  - No other enterprise can boast of more dedicated or more productive members who have given generously of their time and resources to educate each other in all aspects of boating, and to promoting the cause of safe boating through public courses and other civic services
  - A roster of seven squadrons in 1914 has now grown to well over 450 units operating in the continental United States, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, and Japan

#### PILOTING COURSE

January 7 - March 4, 2020



Piloting is the first course in the sequence of USPS courses on navigation, covering coast and inland navigation. This course focuses on navigation as it is done on recreational boats today and embraces GPS as a primary navigation tool while covering enough of traditional techniques so the student will be able to find his/her way even if their GPS fails. The course includes many in-class exercises, developing the student's skills through hands-on practice and learning.

#### Topics covered include:

- Charts and their interpretation
- Navigation aids and how they point to safe water
- Plotting courses and determining direction and distance
- The mariner's compass and converting between True and Magnetic
- Use of GPS typical GPS displays and information they provide, setting up waypoints and routes, staying on a GPS route.
- Pre-planning safe courses and entering them into the GPS
- Monitoring progress and determining position by both GPS and traditional techniques such as bearings and dead reckoning.
- The "Seaman's Eye" simple skills for checking that one is on course.

The course consist of 10 two-hour sessions, every Thursday from 6:00-8:00 p.m.

Classes start January 7 through March 4, 2020

### DECEPTION PASS SAIL AND POWER SQUADRON SAIL COURSE

The SAIL course is a complete sail course created to serve the needs of the novice and experienced sailor, as well as the non-sailor, teaching basic skills and knowledge. The course starts with basic sailboat designs and nomenclature, rigging, safety, sail processes and then tackles the physical aspects of sailing forces and techniques, sail adjustments, marlinespike, helmsmanship and handling of more difficult sailing conditions, navigation rules, and an introduction to heavy weather sailing. Appendices introduce sailboat racing and sailing in Canadian waters.

Cost per member, \$60. Non-members \$80. For spouses or partners sharing a textbook, their fee is an additional \$20.

Class will start October 18, meeting every Thursday except Thanksgiving, for nine weeks.




