Suggestions for submitting Merit Marks (MMs).

I was asked by the D/C to be the new MM chair for the district. I agreed as I am happy to help and have done MMs for over a decade; it is something I can easily do. To help me I have a few suggestions for submitting the MMs (and this should make your job a little easier also). I don't need anything fancy and can take the submissions in most formats or ways. Word files or tables, Excel Spreadsheets, an email. I can convert other formats usually, but not always, so if it is a weird format, please take a snapshot of what you have and send a .jpg. But again, I can deal many other formats.

- Please add your phone number at the top of the submission. If needed I will reach out first on email, but may need to talk. For the subject line: Merit Marks D/16.
- Brevity is key. Please don't submit a long, detailed report. One reason is that there is limited space available in the program. I have done these for such a long time that I have a good idea of all the jobs squadrons and districts have. I usually rewrite what is sent to me.
- Please submit: the person's name, and office he or she holds. The E number isn't needed. Note, provide the name as it shows on the USPS national database (nicknames aren't usually used). The program does the search of the name of record.
- For instructors please submit the class name and the number of classes (not hours) taught. Classes don't need to be mentioned in the narrative.
- For bridge members add the number of hours they worked in their assigned position and just a short description of tasks with the hours. Also submit other tasks.
- For non-bridge members just state the task and the approximate hours worked to the next whole hour.
- For civic service please state what it was and the hours.
- To receive a MM the requirement is 11 hours of work. This includes meetings if there is work done and not general meetings as it is considered a benefit for members. I usually state a submission with 20 hours is best as this gives me some flexibility in my write up.
- Travel time to and from any work event can be counted. Travel time should be included in the hours submitted for the event.
- I ask that the submission be sent to me no later than October 15th. But I will take them earlier as they are submitted. I am required to submit them in November, but prefer to submit them earlier to avoid the rush.
- Finally, if a person has considerably more than the 11 hours required there is no need to put in everything. Just the major accomplishments will suffice.

Thank you for your help in submitting these as they are important for our members, especially when that 25th year MM is achieved, and a Life Member status is given.
