

District 16 Boat Show Booth Instructions

ENTRY TO THE SEATTLE BOAT SHOW:

Parking. We are unable to reimburse for parking expenses.

Parking Lots. One of the parking locations for the Seattle Boat Show is the CenturyLink Event Field Center Parking Garage at 330 S Royal Brougham Way. This garage is attached to the Event Center. There may be other parking lots, the bus is a great mode of transportation too.

Tickets. Pick up your complimentary ticket(s) at the Seattle Boat Show Office. The Office is located at the south end of stadium on the mezzanine level of the parking garage. The Office doors are to the left of the entrance to the Boat Show. Your name has been given to the Show Office; tickets will be under the *USPS/ABClub* name.

If you are the first shift of the day, let the Show Office know you are a volunteer so you can get in early – otherwise they will not let you in until the doors open to the public.

Booth Location. Our booth is number 505 and located in the East Hall, booth 505. The East Hall is on the main floor of the Exhibition Hall. Each aisle is labeled with the aisle number. Look up to find the 500-aisle number.

APPROPRIATE ATTIRE:

1. For a professional look, we request you wear navy/light blue or white squadron or district logo polo shirts or regular shirts/blouses; navy/khaki pants/slacks/skirt. No jeans please.
2. Wearing your squadron or district name badge.

BASIC INFORMATION FOR ALL SHIFTS:

1. Please arrive 15 minutes early so you can receive turnover information from the previous shift.
2. Please do not leave until your replacement arrives!

 - ABClub Education trifold
 - Vessel Safety Check trifold
